WORKERS TO STORM DELHI ON 9,10 & 11 NOVEMBER 2017
CENTRAL TRADE UNIONS' CALL FOR COUNTRYWIDE INDEFINITE STRIKE
AGAINST ANTI-PEOPLE ANTI-LABOUR POLICIES OF NDA GOVERNMENT

The National Convention of workers, held in Delhi on 8th of August last, decided to hold massive **DHARNA** in Delhi on consecutive three days on 9th to 11th of November this year to be followed by indefinite strike in 2018 (date to be decided later) against the anti-people anti-labour policies of NDA government highlighting the following.

12 POINT CHARTER OF DEMANDS

1. Urgent measures for containing price-rise through universalisation of public distribution system and banning speculative trade in commodity market.
2. Containing unemployment through concrete measures for employment generation.
3. Strict enforcement of all basic labour laws without any exception or exemption and stringent punitive measures for violation of labour laws.
4. Universal social security cover for all workers.
5. Minimum wages of not less than Rs.18,000/- per month with provisions of indexation.
6. Assured enhanced pension not less than Rs.3,000/- p.m. for the entire working population.
7. Stoppage of disinvestment in Central/State PSUs and strategic sale.
8. Stoppage of contractorisation in permanent perennial work and payment of same wage and benefits for contract workers as regular workers for same and similar work.
9. Removal of all ceilings on payment and eligibility of bonus, provident fund; increase the quantum of gratuity.

10. Compulsory registration of trade unions within a period of 45 days from the date of submitting application; and immediate ratification of ILO Conventions C-87 and C-98.
11. Against Labour Law Amendments.
12. Against FDI in Railways, Insurance and Defence.

Our Federation is one of the constituent organisations that convened the Convention and supported the declaration that was adopted in the Convention.

We are therefore duty bound to participate in the Dharna programme on all the three days but in view of the March to Parliament programme at the call of UFBU that we participated on 15th September last in a big way, our participation this time will be in representative form but participation has to be from all our State Units with a minimum of the following number mentioned against each Unit:

Andhra Pradesh - 5, Bihar - 10, Chandigarh - 10, Chattishgarh - 5, Delhi - 50, Haryana - 5, Himachal Pradesh - 5, Jharkand - 5, Gujrat - 2, Karnataka - 5, Kerala - 10, Eastern Maharastra - 2, Western Maharastra - 5, Manipur - 2, Madhya Pradesh - 5, NER - 5, Odisha - 10, Punjab - 10, Rajasthan - 10, Tamilnadu - 10, Telengana - 5, Tripura - 2, Uttarakhand - 2, Uttar Pradesh - 5, West Bengal - 30

Comrades, while making preparations for participation in the Delhi programme, Units are also to be in touch with other fraternal organisations for joining the State level preparatory programmes and unleash independent campaign among all sections of bank employees on the 12 point demands.
