Delhi Dharna on 21st March 2018

United Forum of Bank Unions (UFBU) held an urgent meeting on 23rd February 2018 in Chennai. After taking stock of the latest developments and situation in the industry the meeting decided to **defer** the call, of country-wide bank **strike** that was slated to be observed on **15th March 2018**, given from previous UFBU meeting held in Mumbai on 6th February 2018.

UFBU further decided to hold a **Dharna in Delhi on 21st March 2018** to highlight its view of the recent developments following from the multi crore scam in some banks that came to surface recently and also to highlight other important issues emanating from the anti-people policies of the Central Government having relevance to the banking industry in particular and the financial sector in general.


Our participation in the Dharna will be by all our Central Committee members and all Office Bearers of our State Units. In case, however, any of our Central Committee member or any of our State Unit Office Bearer is not in a position to participate due to any unavoidable reason, concerned state unit/s must ensure participation of other leading comrade/s from the state in substitution of such member/s. State Federations are to make their arrangement of stay in Delhi.

All state units are to continue the programme of collecting mass signatures till 19th of this month and bring the collated signature sheets to Delhi while coming for participation in the Dharna. State UFBU is to hold **Press Meet** in all state capitals and Press Hand Out for which will be provided by national Convener of UFBU.

The Delhi Dharna will be followed by further programmes to be announced by UFBU as per decision of Chennai meeting. On our part, all our state units have to take the initiative to rouse people's voice against FRDI Bill and to strengthen the confidence of depositors on the banking system of our country particularly on the public sector banks. These aspects have to be given top priority by all our activists.
